



To enhance the quality of our products and services, we are committed to the renovation of our facilities and investment in updating the hotel's infrastructure. From 2003–2009, the Keio Plaza Hotel Tokyo spent more than 10 billion yen on a large-scale renovation project, while still making significant advances in the hotel's restaurant business. We continue to invest in renovation every year in order to maintain the level of sophistication in our design and to make critical upgrades to the hotel's functions.


