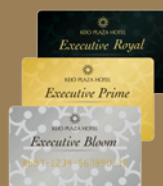

# Sports News Photograph Exhibition 2016

## Ali & other athletes competing in global sporting events

—from September 1 to  
November 14

The third annual photographic exhibition celebrating sports will be held in the lobby of the South Tower on the third floor, as well as along the second floor corridor and in front of the main bar, Brilliant. Professional photographers from The Mainichi Newspapers and The Sports Nippon Newspapers will contribute 50 arresting photographs capturing the drama of athletes competing at various global sporting events.

One of the main displays of photos will honor the memory of legendary boxer Muhammed Ali, one of the world's most recognised sports figures, who passed away in June. Among the moments captured for posterity is Ali's 1976 fight with Antonio Inoki, one of Japan's most famous professional wrestlers.

Muhammed Ali was a guest at Keio Plaza Hotel at that time, staying for 12 nights in the Imperial Suite. While he was here, Ali played some of his favorite tunes on our grand piano and enjoyed a meal of chateaubriand steak for breakfast. Pictures from his days in Japan also provide a glimpse into the personal side of The Greatest, including images of Ali jogging in the early morning hours around Shinjuku. A walk around the lobby will take you back to priceless moments, including scenes of his public workouts and pre-fight press conference — and that historic June fight.
