First Hotel in Japan to Open “My Melody” and “Kuromi” Guest Rooms,
Popular Hello Kitty Guest Rooms Also Open in the Summer of 2023

Tokyo, Japan – [Keio Plaza Hotel Tokyo](#) (KPH), one of Japan’s most prestigious hotel companies operating hotels in the Shinjuku district of Tokyo and other locations, is proud to announce that our Keio Plaza Hotel Hachioji will open theme guest rooms based upon “Hello Kitty” and “My Melody / Kuromi”, highly popular characters of the “Hello Kitty” Japanese cartoon series produced by the Sanrio Co., Ltd.. Two rooms in each theme for a total of four new theme rooms will be opened in the summer of 2023.
