– 4,500 Magnificent Hanging Art Ornament Display and Special Menus

TOKYO - [Keio Plaza Hotel Tokyo](#) (KPH), one of Japan’s most prestigious international hotels located in Shinjuku, Tokyo, will host an event entitled “Hina-matsuri” to celebrate Japan’s cultural event known as Girls’ Doll Festival from February 1 (Wednesday) to March 31 (Friday), 2023.
