The rooms will also provide a small elevated seating area as a special space for guests to enjoy cozy and relaxing gatherings with their family and friends.

The two other rooms are the first to portray the themes of the two Sanrio characters "My Melody" and her self-proclaimed rival "Kuromi" at any hotel within Japan, and they have been created in a cute and stylish motif using shades of pink and purple colors.
